



The Baptist Fellowship of Randolph will be hosting a "Manger Build" on Saturday, December 17th from 10am - 12pm.

The estimated time to build the manger is 30 minutes. Families can begin their manger any time between 10:00 am and noon.

What is a "Manger Build"?

In an effort to refocus the Christmas season on Christ, fathers come together and help the children in their lives build a manger. This manger is then placed near the family Christmas tree as a reminder that Jesus is the real reason for the season. A simple, seven-day devotional is provided with the manger which the father can read to the children once a day leading up to Christmas.

What do we need to bring?

Very simply: yourself and the kids! All materials for building the manger including tools, wood, instructions, and help will be provided free of charge.

What if dad isn't available?

Any man in the lives of the children is welcome to come and participate. There will also be men from the church available to help any children without a father/brother/uncle/grandfather attending.

What will the moms do?

While the men and children work downstairs in Joseph's carpenter shop building the mangers, all the moms are welcome to fellowship and relax upstairs in Mary's coffee shop.
